Introduction

This Fact Sheet provides some information on holidays and breaks for carers and the people they look after. It is divided into sections according to the scope of the information.

It is worth going to local public libraries and/or making online searches for information on holidays for disabled people. Tourist Information Centres in most cities and large towns should have information on local accommodation with wheelchair access and other services and facilities accessible to wheelchair users.

Carers may wish to take a holiday without the person they care for. The person will then need someone to provide him/her with care. Using registered home care providers may be an option. Some of these provide live-in services. Alternatively, arranging a short break in a residential home may be appropriate. Further information in this regard can be found in our Fact Sheet No 3 - Respite Care Services.

If the person cared for wishes to take a holiday on his/her own it may be possible to arrange for helpers or care staff through the organisations that provide the holidays. Some examples of this are given under the section Holidays For Cared For People.

The Carers Hub is a focal point to help unpaid carers in Brighton and Hove get the information, advice and support that they need. This may be useful to you in respect of holidays and breaks.

Brighton and Hove City Council

.1 Mindfulness Course

This eight week course for adult carers (two hours a week) is funded by the City Council and the Brighton and Hove Clinical Commissioning Group. It builds skills to deal with a range of problems such as stress, depression and anxiety. Techniques are used to address what is happening in the mind and body.

.2 Carers Weekend Break

This weekend break which is for carers aged 18 and over looking after another adult, is organised by the Council once a year in partnership with Roffey Park. It is fully funded by the Council. It gives carers the chance to relax and unwind, meet other carers and try out different activities to help look after their health and wellbeing. A carer will need a current carer's assessment.
